

HISTORY OF THE MOORE FAMILY

(Written by Sarah E. Moore for the Moore Reunion held at Goodrich Park, Winchester, Indiana, in the year 1927 and finished in August, 1933.)

A short sketch and history of William and Sarah Moore, their descendants; Also their brothers and sisters and their ancestors.

William Moore and Sarah McNate were married in County Down, Ireland. They had born to them, ten children, as follows:

Alexander	Sarah
Samuel	Three infants named Isaac
James	One infant unnamed

In the following paragraphs are a few incidents of the life of William and Sarah Moore in Ireland and their voyage across the sea.

Sarah said she had a chance to keep a little infant that was about the same age as one of her babies (Alexander I think), for a rich man and his wife. She was to give it the same care that she would her own infant and keep it until it was weaned. The man said he would pay her well for it and his wife said she would give Sarah nice presents that would make up a good deal. They wanted her if they could get her because they thought she seemed so healthy and a good nurse for the baby. Sarah wanted to take the baby because she thought it was a good chance to make some money but William would not listen to it. He did not want her to take on anything to help make the living as he thought it was a poor man that could not maintain a wife and family. Sarah run a little grocery in Ireland for a time, but William had her give that up too.

When they got ready to come to the United States they said to come on a ship that came to New York, but before they got on the ship it was completely loaded and they would not let them get on so they had to wait for the next ship. That ship came to New Orleans. The shipping company boarded them while they waited for the second ship. When they got on the ship it took some time to finish loading, but they got their load and moved a long distance out to sea before Sarah realized they were moving, the water was so calm and smooth.

William was up ondeck a good deal with the sailors. He saw at one time, two ships going full sail in opposite directions, their ship and another one. He asked the sailors how it happened that they were both going full speed in opposite directions. They told him they were in the region of the trade winds. He also saw the Gulf Stream while on deck.

William and Sarah Moore are both buried in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery, about three miles north of Lynn, Indiana. Also their sons, Alexander, Samuel, James, William John and George Washington. Their other children are buried at Oxford, Butler County, Ohio.

The four oldest sons went to school at Oxford, Ohio. The school was on the same campus grounds as Miami University. Miami University grounds cover an entire township.

The following names of relatives of William and Sarah McNate Moore were obtained by Nancy Noten Moore from Sarah McNate Moore, one day when Sarah was visiting her son, Samuel and family. Nancy wrote the names down as Sarah told her so we feel like they are correct.

William Moore's father, Samuel Moore, married Sarah, daughter of William Officer, in County Down, Ireland. The following children were born to them:

William Moore's father died when he was quite young and he helped his widowed mother raise the family. He was head of the family. If the children needed a little correcting, it is said that he did some of the correcting.

Sarah McNate Moore's father's name was Alexander McNate. I have learned lately that the McNates were Scotch. Her mother's name was Sarah Haise. Her grandfather was Harry McNate and her grandmother was Kate Holaca.

Above are recorded the names of William Moore's father and mother; all of his brothers and sisters and all of the brothers and sisters of his father and his grandfather, William Officer.

There are also the names of Sarah McNate Moore's father and mother; all of her brothers and sisters and all the brothers and sisters of her father as well as the sisters of her mother. These records go far back in the seventeenth century. William and Sarah McNate Moore's grandparents were all born before our Revolutionary War Period, about 1760 or 1770.

William Moore was born in the year 1810 and died December 18, 1888. Sarah, wife of William, was born August 12, 1818 and died December 29, 1893.

The following is an exact copy of an article written by Alexander Moore and was found in one of his books.

In Memoriam

Sarah Moore was born in County Down, Ireland, August 12, 1818 and died in Randolph County, Indiana, December 29, 1893. Her parents were primitive Methodists. She was born, nurtured and converted in that faith. She leaves five sons. Three of them served their country and humanity to uphold law, order and unity.

Dear Mother, thou are now at rest,
Thy form we cannot see,
We feel thou are with the blest
Wherever they may be.

Alexander Moore, son of William and Sarah McNate Moore, was born in County Down, Ireland in November 1839. He died in October 31, 1912 at the home of his brother George, in Randolph County, Indiana. He never married. He volunteered and served nearly three years in the Civil War, in the 69th Indiana Infantry. He composed many pieces of poetry for his reunions. They all contained several historical events of the war and were greatly enjoyed by his old comrades. They called him their "Regimental Poet". He also wrote some other poems. He took several newspapers and always seemed to be pretty well posted on current events. He taught one term of school. Alexander was Administrator a few times and Census Enumerator once. He left eighty acres of land and some other property.

The following epilogue was written by Alexander Moore for School District No. 11 in Greensfork Township for term of school ending March 1906. Several of us attended school at No. 11, so I thought it might be interesting for some of us to read.

Dear Schoolmates, this term now ends,
But let us still be good friends,
And in the world's mysterious maze
When we wend our separate ways
Don't forget your dear school days
And always give your Master praise.

In the trials, toils and strife
On the battlefield of life
Keep the Master's form in view
Always to yourself be true
Then Schoolhouse Number Eleven
Will be a station on the way to Heaven
Where we will all meet again
At the Master's call.--Amen.

The Austin School was built in the spring of 1861, the year the Civil War began. Uncle Alexander taught school in the Austin Schoolhouse, School District No. 11. It was the first school house ever built in District No. 11. We now occupy this school house for a residence. (August, 1933).

Samuel Moore, son of William and Sarah Moore, was born in Newtonard, County Down, Ireland, September 29, 1841. He died April 16, 1913 at the home of his son, Warren Moore, in Randolph County, Indiana. He left 40 acres of land and other property. He enlisted twice for the Civil War. Once he enlisted in Co. K, 86th Ohio Infantry and then as substitute for William Baily in Co. B, 9th Indiana Infantry for which he was paid \$600.00. He married Nancy Woten, daughter of Henry and Sarah Williams Woten in September 1865, by old Thomas Hough in Spartanburg. Samuel and Nancy Woten Moore had born to them ten children, as follows:

Samuel and Nancy Moore moved to Jay County soon after they were married and lived there about two years. They lived in a

two-story hewed log house by a woods that was seven miles across it one way, which was a very large woods at that time. Samuel killed Nancy Woten Moore died November 22, 1923, at her own home.

James Moore, son of William and Sarah Moore, was born in County Down, Ireland in 1844 and died at his home in Lynn, Indiana December 18, 1926. His wife died June 3, 1931. He left a home in Lynn, Indiana and other property. He enlisted in Co. B, 7th Indiana Cavalry for three years in the Civil War. He married Sabilla Jean, daughter of John Francis and Mary Ann Lord Hondorph in Mechanicsburg, Sangamon County, Illinois, March 3, 1868. James and Sabilla Moore had born to them eleven children, as follows:

James Moore and his wife, Sabilla and their two children, Ida and Willie moved from Champaigne, Illinois to Randolph County, Indiana about the year of 1875. They stopped on their way out here at Springfield, Illinois, and viewed the tomb of Abraham Lincoln.

Grandfather Moore told me one time when he was talking about his folks that it did not make any difference what Charley Hanly and his sister Maria went into, they generally got a little money out of it.

William J. Moore, son of William and Sarah Moore, was born in County Down, Ireland, February 29, 1846. He died at his home, which was also the home of his grandson, John Jennings, in August 1923. He married Elizabeth, daughter of Henry and Sarah Williams Woten in the year of 1868 or 1869 by Jesse Barnes near old Snowhill. They rode to Jesse's home on horseback. They lived with William and Sarah Moore until they built them a log house on Alexander's farm. They had born to them four children, as follows:

- Twin boys, named Franklin and Washington.
- Franklin (Frankie) Died July 16, 1874.

The mother died when the twins were two or three days old, Feb. 19. 1874.

William J. Moore has eighteen or nineteen great grandchildren and four grandchildren, but no children living now.

George W. Moore, son of William and Sarah Moore, was born near Oxford, Butler County, Ohio in 1860. He died February 20, 1921. He left two 80-acre farms. He married Emma, daughter of Joseph and Rachel Fry Eisenhour, April 1880. They had born to them seven children, as follows:

Emma, wife of George W. Moore, is the only member of the family of William and Sarah Moore who is now living, August, 1933. Emma Moore died February 28, 1936.

William J. Moore left a farm of 60 acres. William J. worked two or three years in Union Co. Indiana. He worked for Dan Moss and for a McConaha, but I do not remember his first name. McConaha had a little boy named Joe. He would carry drinks to Uncle Bill and when he would get near he would call out, "Bill, Oh, Bill, Joe's acoming Bill." Uncle Bill thought lots of the little fellow.

George W. Moore and wife Emma took up house keeping in the same house that William J. built for he and his wife to take up house keeping on Uncle Alex's farm. A part of George's family was born in that house and all of William J's. children were born there. We think George Washington Moore was born on Doc Goodrich's farm because William and Sarah and family lived on Doc Goodrich's farm a couple of years before they moved out here. George W. was a year old when they moved here to Sandoloh Co., in the Spring of 1861.

George W. Moore and Emma Eisenhour were married April 10, 1880 by Jesse Barnes near old Snowhill. They rode in a buggy to Jesse's house to be married.

William Moore liked to see the country improve and was pleased when something new came. He threwed in oak trees for railroad ties and made the ties for a railroad that was going to come through

this community. The company built some of the railroad and broke up and never finished the road through here, but took grandfather's ties. He put a team of horses a few times with three other teams to help pull the old tumbling shaft power to run the thrashing machine. He hated to see his team work at that and was much pleased to see the steam engines do the work and when the old traction engines came, he was pleased and rode home from here one time on the first traction engine that thrashed here. When grandfather moved to Randolph County, there were no reapers or thrashing machines, but they came a few years later.

A CORRECTION: William Moore and family lived on "Doc" Goodrich's farm two years before they came to Randolph County. Sarah Moore worked at making ladies hats, weaving them out of straw and also knit lace to sell and trimmed hats while she was a girl, but not after she was married.

My mother said the first reapers came around here during the Civil War. The first one she saw was just north of old Snowhill.

Andrew Moore landed at New Orleans from County Down, Ireland and worked his way up the river to where near Oxford, Butler Co., Ohio now stands. He lived there until he came to south of Richmond, someplace, I do not know just where. Uncle Andy visited with us several weeks in the winter of 1880 and 1881. It was very cold when he was at our house. He slept on a bed not very far from the heating stove. He said when he was leaving he hated to leave that good warm bed. He also visited his brother, William and William's son, George and maybe some others while he was here.

William Moore, Sr., left 56 acres of land and other property. William claimed to be Scotch Irish, but I do not know how unless the Officers were Scotch. From all accounts I believe the Moore Family were Irish, but it is very likely his mother was of Scotch decent, as I have lately heard that the McNates were Scotch-Party.

Sarah Moore's people were Irish, I believe, all of them, ^{corrected above} William Moore worked in England a good deal when a young man. He said they were very proud and did not like for their hired help to eat with them, but he did not happen to be used that way. He also said he got most of his education in night schools in Ireland. He said a real nice old man taught these schools. The teacher would teach a while and talk to them how they should behave and sort of give them little lectures.

My father, Samuel Moore, was born in a small town by the name of Newtonard not very far from Belfast and very likely some of or maybe all of his brothers that were born in Ireland. I remember hearing Uncle Andy say something about Newtonard and Londonderry, but can't remember what it was that he was talking about. I do not know for sure what regiment Uncle Andy was in, but think it was the 124th. Neither do I know what he worked at. My grandmother Moore said Aunt Jane Moore made some real fancy looking dresses with hand embroidery and sold them for good prices. Sometimes she got premiums on her work. Grandmother seemed to be proud of Aunt Jane's work.

William Moore's sister, Matilda, came with him to the United States in the year of 1850, to Oxford, Ohio. She married Thomas Lambert of Oxford and lived there several years. We have lost trace of her. I do not think she had any children.

William Moore's brother, Samuel, went to Australia. He had a large family of girls. We have also lost trace of him.

William Moore's sister, Maria married Charles Hanley in County Down, Ireland. They came to the United States before William Moore did. Uncle Charlie Hanley got \$500.00 to go back to Ireland and testify in court that a man had died here so they could settle up an estate in Ireland. While he was there he talked William and Sarah Moore in the notion of coming to this country. They returned with him.

Uncle Charlie and Aunt Maria were both financiers and could get money. When William Moore landed in New Orleans he only had 75¢ and Uncle Charlie helped him get to Oxford, Ohio. He lived at Oxford several years and then moved to Vermillion County, Ill. Some time in the sixties it was when he moved, I think. They had a family, but we do not know how many children. We have lost trace of them so far.

Grandfather Moore told me one time that his sister, Ellen Jane was the most sensible one of the family. We have lost trace of her.

William Moore's sister, Ellen Jane remained in Ireland as far as I know and never married that I know of. His brother, Andrew Moore was the youngest of the family. Andrew married Jane Hamilton in County Down, Ireland. Their daughter, Mary, was born there in 1850. Andrew and his family came to the United States in the year 1852. His mother came with him and made her home with him. Grandmother Moore thought the negro people in this country were terrible looking. Uncle Andy's wife was a fine seamstress and made many nice dresses and things and took to the fairs in Ireland. She was also a nice housekeeper. 'Tis said she was very proud and wanted everything nice and up to date. Uncle Andy told us when he was visiting us that Jane would have her children dressed like other people if it took the last cent. He seemed common and everyday like, but seemed to be proud of his family. He talked about them at different times. His son, Sam, came to our house while Uncle Andy was there. Uncle Andy was so pleased to see his son that he was almost overjoyed and could hardly eat his supper that evening. Sam stayed at our house two or three days. Uncle Andy went away with Sam and that was the last we ever saw either of them. That was in the spring of 1881. Sam was a nice looking young man.

Uncle Andy was interested in we children while he was at our house. Ma said about the last words that he said when he was leaving was that he told Pa and Ma to take good care of us as we

were near to him. Uncle Andy seemed hearty and jolly while he was there. He was never sick and always helped do all the chores. He was a very entertaining talker, and could tell lots of stories about Ireland. Some of our neighbors got to coming in of a night to talk with him. We all like d Uncle Andy.

Jim came to our house once, but he never came in the house. He talked with my father and then went away.

Andrew's daughter, Mary was a pretty girl, I've heard. She married Benton L. Woodward. He died in 1917 aged 63 years. Mary died in 1925, aged 75 years. Their son, Walter has five children and four grandchildren. William B. has one son and one daughter.

Emma Jane Spencer of Indianapolis has four children and some grandchildren.

Margaret Demaree of Dublin, Indiana, has no children.

Mayme Laymon died in 1926, leaving a boy and a girl.

Clarence died in 1906, aged 20 years.

Della Holt lives at Greenfield, Indiana.

Walter Woodward lives at Cambridge City, Indiana and William B. lives at Dublin.

The following Historical data was given to me by William B. Woodward:

Andrew Moore was born in Scotland in 1823, and his wife Jane Hamilton Moore was born in County Down, Ireland in 1825. They were married in Ireland in 1849 and came to the United States in 1852, landing at New Orleans. They settled at Oxford, Ohio. Andrew Moore served as private in the Union Army in the Civil War, enlisting as a private at Centerville, Indiana, in Co. F. 124 Ind. Inf. He died near Cambridge City, in 1891.

Andrew Moore was born in 1823 and died in 1891. He married Jane Hamilton who was born in 1825. They were married in 1849 and she died in 1905. Following is a list of their children:

One son and one daughter who died in infancy.

Mary Eliza Moore, born in County Down, Ireland, 1850 and died at Dublin, Indiana in 1926. She married Benton L. Woodward in 1873, who was born in 1854 and died in 1917. The following names are the children of Mary Eliza Moore Woodward:

James Moore, son of Andrew and Jane Hamilton Moore was born in Wayne Co. in 1853 and died at Connorsville, Indiana in 1926. He married Mary Alice Higgins in 1879. She died in 1930. The following is a list of the names of their children:

Mattie Moore, born in 1887 and married George Ludlow in 1913. They had no children.

Samuel Moore, son of Andrew and Jane Hamilton Moore was born in Wayne County, Indiana in 1856 and died in 1930. He married a lady whose first name was Orpha and she was born in 1874 and died in 1922. They were married in 1901. Following is a list of their children:

Della M. Woodward married Howard Holt in 1911. They have one son, Glendon E. Holt born in 1919.

Clarence Woodward, who died single.

James Moore lived in Connersville several years. His daughter Madie Moore Ludlow lives on a farm near Connersville. They have no children. Samuel Moore's daughter Marie married a man by the name of Howard Huddleston. They have three children and live in Richmond. *now have 6 children all live in Richmond.*

Uncle Andrew Moore died in 1891 and his wife Jane, died in 1905. They both died at their sons' home, Sam and Andy near

Cambridge City. James died in 1926. His son died in 1925. Andrew died December 1930 in Cambridge City at Belle Monder's home. His other son, Samuel Moore died at the I.O.O.F. Home in Greensburg, Indiana, March 3, 1930.

uncle Andrew Moore was a soldier in the Civil War. Aunt Jane Moore had a brother, "Pat" Hamilton, that came to this country.

Aunt Emma told me of an incident that happened while Uncle Andy was visiting them during the winter of 1881. Aunt Emma thought that Andy and Uncle George, who was helping him, would want to start to work early so she got up and prepared breakfast and washed the dishes and made the beds. Since the clock had stopped, and it was still dark, they all began to fall sleepy. Uncle Andy went out and looked at the stars, then coming back into the house said if his bed wasn't already made he believed that he would go back to bed. It was then that they realized that they had gotten up at twelve o'clock and it was then two. Aunt Emma assured them that the beds could be made again and they all went back to bed.

William and Sarah Moore came to the United States from County Down, Ireland from the seaport of Belfast on an old wooden sail ship to New Orleans and up the Mississippi River to Cincinnati and settled in Oxford, Butler County, Ohio in the year of 1850. They brought with them four children, Alexander, Samuel, James and William John Jr; also William Moore's sister, Matilda. They lived in Oxford until they came to Randolph County in the spring of 1861. Then they bought a farm, clearing it off and building a home in which they lived until they died. William was a carpenter by trade, specializing in houses. He worked at this trade about all the time until 1861 when he went to farming. Sarah worked at making ladies hats. She wove the straw for them and also knit lace to sell before she was married. Her youngest brother, Alexander McNate, worked in a piano factory in Belfast, Ireland. He received good wages and brought her many nice presents from the city. Her sister, Kate, married a rich man and lived real well. Her father, Alexander McNate, died while she was quite young and her widowed mother raised her.

It took eleven weeks and three days for William and Sarah Moore to come to this country. They encountered several storms; some were very severe. They tore away some of the ship's rigging and they had to throw overboard some of the cargo. They had to stop at Havana, Cuba, to get provisions and water to come on. They lived on West Church and Mulberry Streets in Oxford.

Neither William nor Sarah liked debt. They would not buy unless they had the money to pay. They always seemed to have money to buy what they needed. William and Sarah never went around so very much after they came to Randolph County, but they borrowed Henry and Sarah Wooten's buggy. It was the only buggy in the neighborhood at that time, which was during the Civil War. They hitched their

Julia were up to the buggy and both of them drove down into Union County to John Mosse's to get their son Sam's clothes and things that he left there when he went to enlist in the war. Sam had been working for John Mosse. Julia was one of a nice team of Irish greys that William Moore brought with him from Oxford. The other was old Tim.

William Moore was a pretty good carpenter. He made the wagon complete that his son Sam intended to drive out to Nebraska to try to get a government claim of land. This was about the year 1870 or 1871. They put a cover on the wagon and his wife Nancy and two children and William A. Lorton were going with him. They finally decided to remain here after they were about all ready to go.

That fall they took the covered wagon and went to Paulding County, Ohio, deer hunting. I do not think they got any deer but it got cool enough before they got back that they had to wrap the covers around them pretty close. The party that went deer hunting was Henry Lorton, William A. Lorton, Samuel Moore, William J. Moore and George Perkins.

William Moore's mother was a very fair complexioned woman and a fine dancer. She was also a very proud lady of fine appearance.

Sarah Moore's mother was a very strict Methodist and was very watchful of her children.

I have named a few things that I remember as told me, just to give a glimpse of what some of our ancestors were. The Moores claim to be Scotch-Irish, but I have definitely found out that they are as the McMates were Scotch.

* * * * *

I will try to describe some of the characteristics and will attempt a word picture of William and Sarah Moore, as I remember them and knew them for the benefit of those who do not know.

William was about 5 ft. 6 or 7 in. in height. He was well built, and stout but not fleshy looking, rather slow of movement real fair complexioned. His face was smooth and rosy looking, for an old man. He had blue eyes and his hair was real grey, but they said his hair was always light in color. He was a nice looking old man. He had a short crisp way of talking and generally meant just about what he said but would joke a little sometimes. He had a real nice singing voice and was great to hum over songs when he was working at his bench or husking out shock fodder. I used to like to hear him sing. I remember hearing him sing "Auld Lang Syne", "The Farmer's Boy", "Annie Laurie", "Buy a Broom", and "There's A Difference Between A Beggan and A Queen". He had a big knot on one of his thumbs, caused by a blow of a hammer. That was the only blemish that I can remember.

Sarah was real short and very shapely and neat looking. She always remained that way. She was fair complexioned and had blue eyes. She had lovely hair of a reddish brown color. It laid in deep waves across her head. She twisted her hair at the back of her neck, parted it in the middle. It lay in notches along her forehead. She was very sprightly and quick to move. She was real nice looking, and smoked a clay pipe, lit with a coal of fire, mostly. She commenced smoking when her boys were in the war. She said it helped her pass away the time. Sometimes she smoked T. T. Tobacco. She could make real good biscuits, crackers and pies. you could ~~at~~ always, for a good many years, find some crackers or a pie in the middle drawer of her old bureau where she kept them.

* * * * *

I have decided to include in this book a couple of the poems that Uncle Alex Moore wrote for the reunions of his Regiment, the 69th Indiana Volunteer Infantry. The following is an exact copy of one that was printed at the time in the Union City Times. The reunion was held at Union City, Indiana. The following is the address to Union City, for her magnificent hospitality at the reunion of the 69th Ind. Volunteer Inf. Oct. 12, 1894, by Alex Moore.

Ladies and Gentlemen of Union City
 We are no orator, which is a pity,
 So we have written a little poem
 On patriotism and generosity here at home.
 An here under the Eagle's observant gaze
 We will recite our unpretending lays
 And rhyme aloud our humble rhymes
 Right here before your City Times.

By your good peoples' kind acclaim
 The 69th was invited here by name
 What heart so lost to the kind and good
 But pulsates with true gratitude.
 Union? Expressive name forever dear
 Where we are honored to appear,
 Where every Science, every nobler Art
 That can expand the mind or improve the heart
 Is known as people have often found
 Even in Ohio's Darke Ground.

Here thrift and energy push and force
 Mark the empire's westward course.
 Here liberty and order illustrates nature's plan
 And patriotism roused all the good in man.
 Here taste and eloquence unite
 In Manly vigor and female beauty bright.
 All meet to honor us tonight.
 Goodness of peace and peaceful lays
 Look down with kindly eyes,
 Bless Union City all her days.

With never-ending joys
 Long may she stand to prove our land
 And the honor of our nation
 And may poets bring her praise to sing
 To the remotest generation.
 While the 69th in glory's ranks
 Shout, Union, Union, Thanks, Thanks,
 O, there aligned on glory's shore
 Before the God we all adore
 We will shout Union--evermore.

Note: While attending the reunion of the 69th we invaded the office of Hon. Theodore Shockney who was away from home participating in the Political Campaign. We found Mr. John Shockney running the office, also for trustee or more properly speaking, sitting for Trustee. At present the best thing a candidate can do is sit and we hope he will be successful in his sitting, but not in his candidacy and we wish to return thanks for courtesies received.
